- 1. Remove old coating and sealer with the recommended Pioneer Eclipse stripper following label directions. For optimum results, use a Pioneer Eclipse autoscrubber or stripping machine with recommended Pioneer Eclipse pads or brushes.
- 2. Use a clean mop or autoscrubber to rinse the floor twice using a Pioneer Eclipse neutral cleaner. Rinse floor again with clean, cold water and allow to dry.
- OPTIONAL: Apply 2 thin coats of Pioneer Eclipse sealer to protect high-traffic areas and old or porous floors.
- 4. Apply 4-6 coats of Diamond Shine Floor coating with a clean, synthetic mop.
 - **Note:** Do not exceed an initial application of a combined 6 coats of coating and sealer.
- 5. Allow floor to dry thoroughly between coats and prior to burnishing.

Note: To prevent contamination do not pour unused product from bucket into original container.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: ROUTINE MAINTENANCE

- Sweep floor daily with either a mop treated with EnviroStar Green[®] Dust Mop Treatment, or with an untreated dust mop.
- 2. Mop or autoscrub as necessary with a Pioneer Eclipse Neutral Cleaner following label directions.
- 3. Restore as needed with a Pioneer Eclipse maintainer.
- 4. Burnish as desired with recommended Pioneer Eclipse machine and pad.
- 5. As needed, perform a deep scrub and recoat applying an additional 1-2 coats of Diamond Shine Floor Coating.
- 6. Allow floor to dry thoroughly between coats and prior to burnishing.
- 7. When stripping is necessary, remove coating and sealer with a recommended Pioneer Eclipse stripper.
